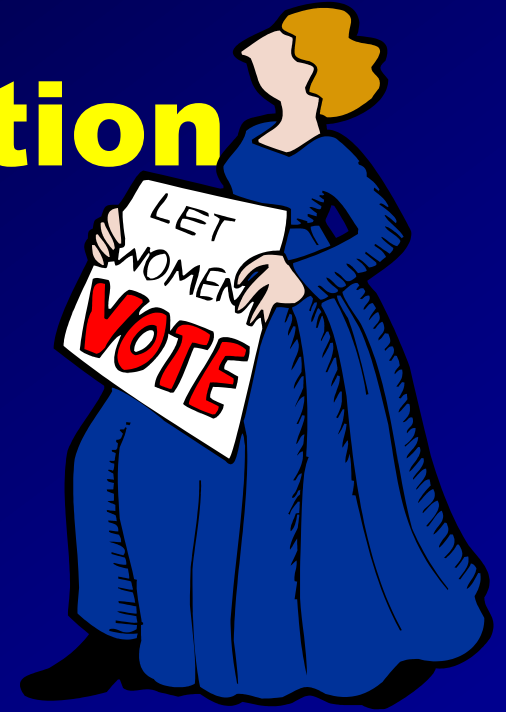

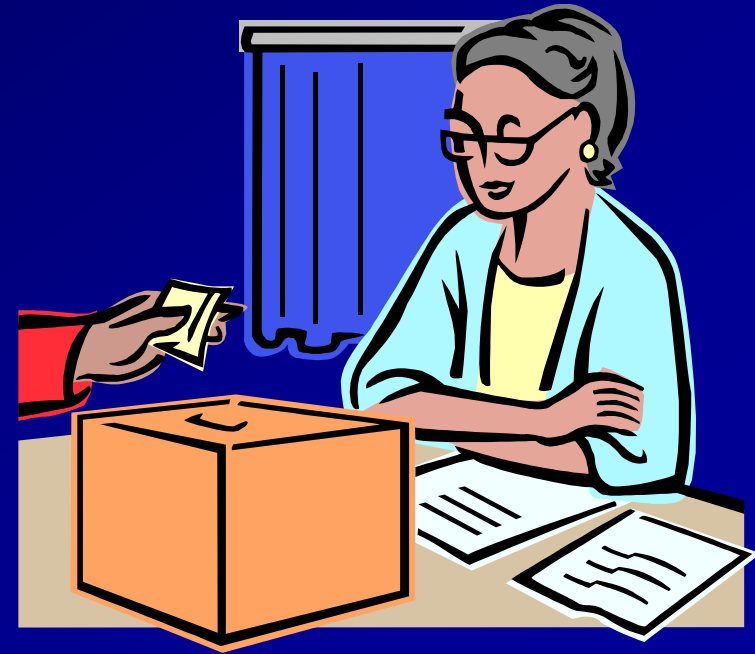

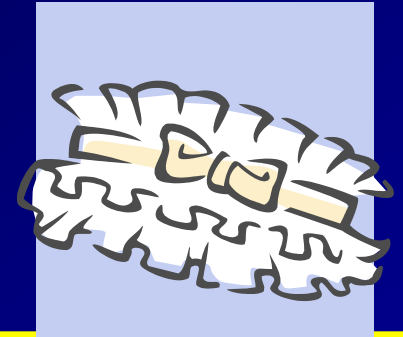

In 1984, women's voting rates in presidential elections surpassed those of men for the first time since the Census Bureau began collecting voting data in 1964. Women's voting rates have been higher than men's ever since.**

Most men and women agree that opportunities to get hired at the junior level are the same regardless of gender for equally qualified candidates, a new survey shows, according to a survey reported in the Wall Street Journal. But women actually hold a much smaller portion of leadership roles than men. A December 2009 study from New York research organization Catalyst Inc., shows that just 3percent of chief executives officers and 13.5 percent of all executive-officer positions within Fortune 500 companies today are women.
